Bubba's friends and family are welcomed as they bring his body to the church where it will be honored with a Christian burial. His casket is sprinkled with holy water and clothed with the funeral pall recalling his baptism into Christ's death and resurrection. A crucifix, a symbol of Bubba's faith, is placed upon the Pall. The Rosary reflects his seeking Christ in the mysteries of the rosary of the Blessed Mother. The Easter Candle, symbol of our hope and faith in life coming out of death, stands near the place where Bubba's body will rest for the funeral Mass.
